Adaptive Learning

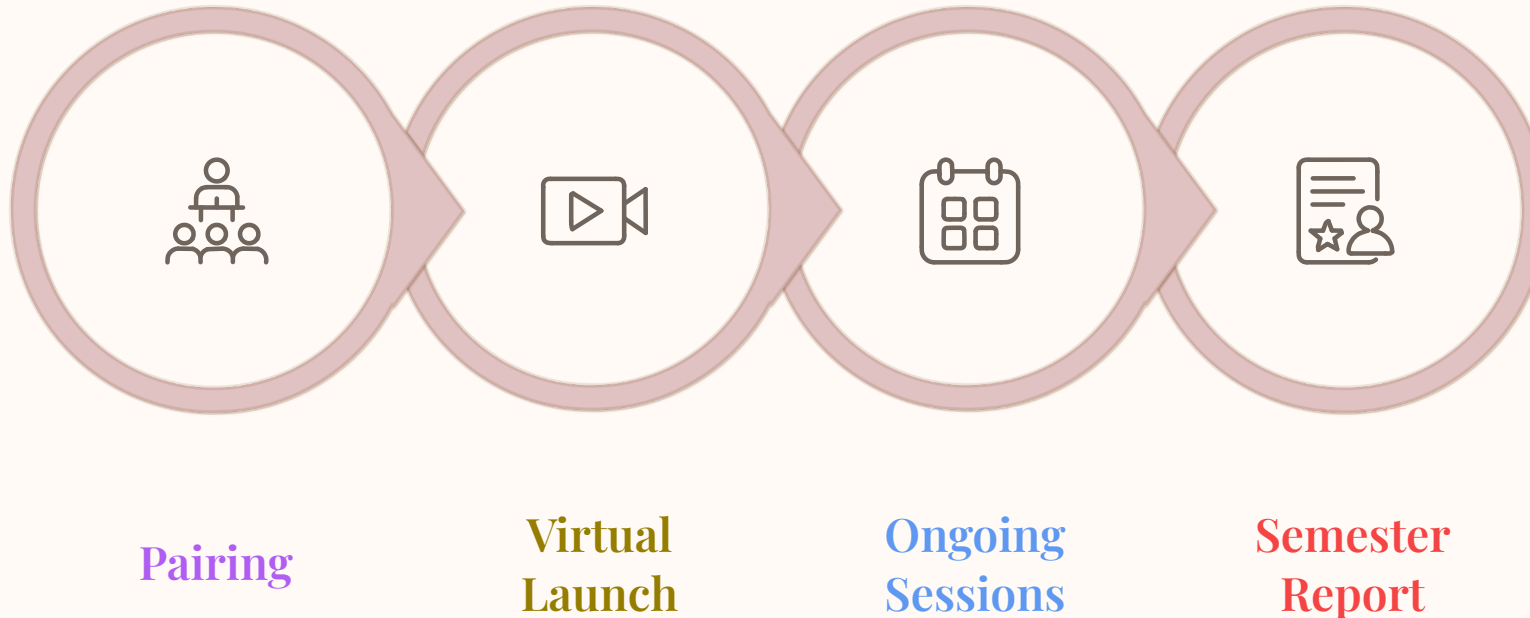
Recognizing that every student learns differently, mentors experiment with approaches suited to each individual.

The program is designed to be flexible and student-driven. After the official virtual launch, student groups coordinate directly with their mentors to schedule regular online sessions — typically once or twice a month — based on mutual availability.

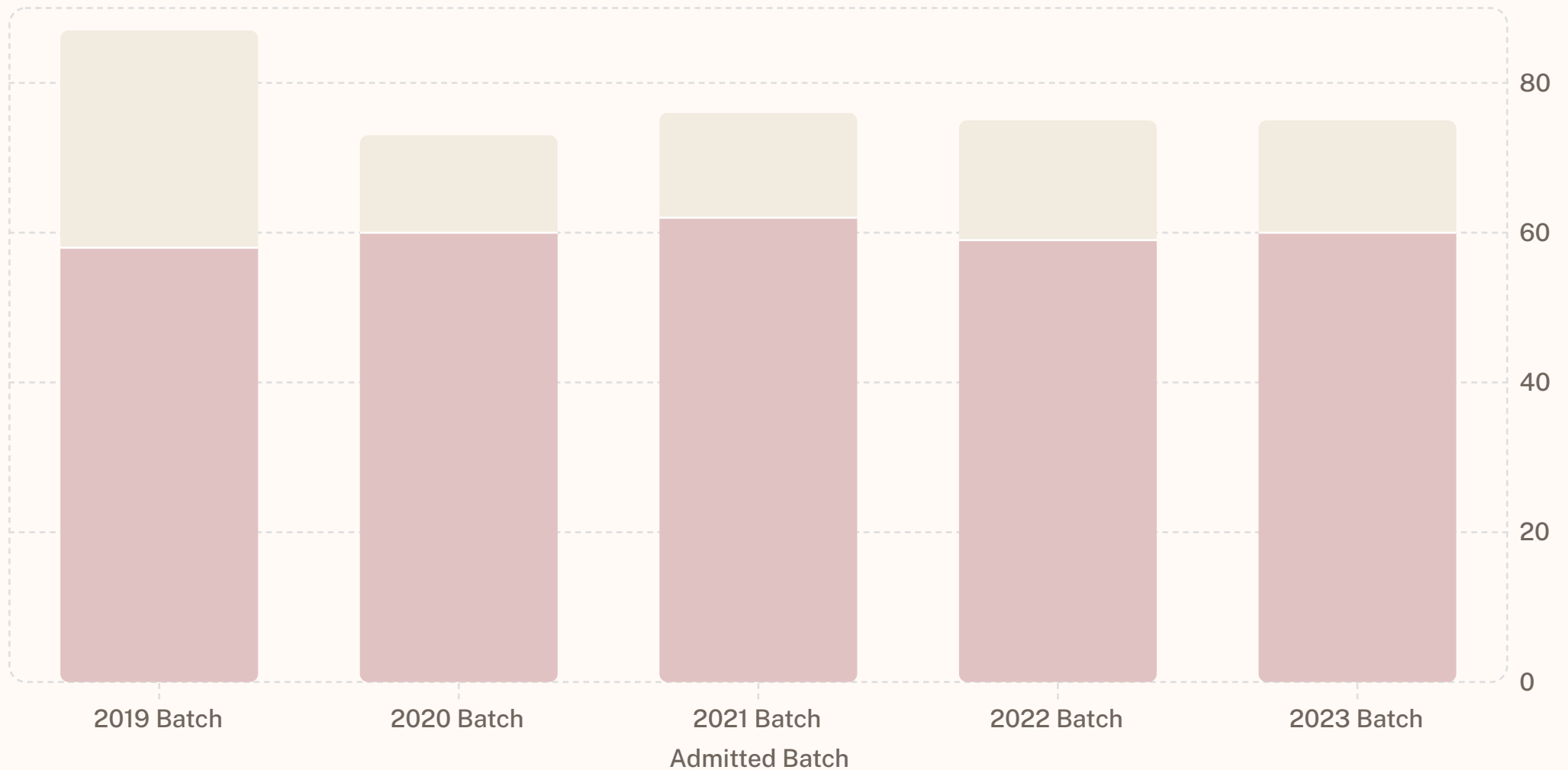
