Key Highlights of the Session

Guidance was provided on preparing for state and national level entrance exams, emphasizing logical reasoning, mathematical foundations, and technical proficiency.

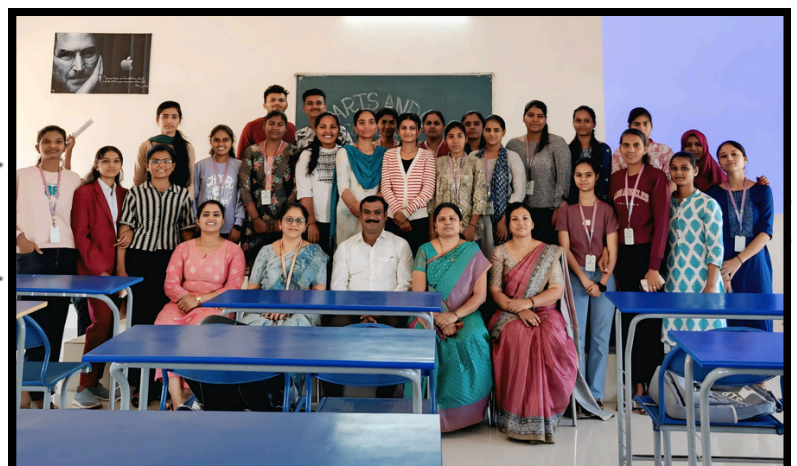
Interactive Q&A and Student Engagement

The session concluded with a vibrant interaction where students raised queries regarding curriculum choices, industry expectations, and the balance between academic theory and practical skill development. Prof. Magi shared valuable advice on building a strong technical portfolio and the importance of continuous learning in the fast-evolving tech landscape.



Expert Session on Artificial Intelligence at Shree Tammannappa Chikkodi College, Banahatti

On April 4, 2026, **Prof. Sudha K. S.** and **Prof. Karuna Kurbet** were invited as expert resource persons to **Shree Tammannappa Chikkodi (STC) Arts, Science, Commerce, BBA & BCA College, Banahatti**. The faculty members delivered an in-depth technical talk titled "**Fundamentals of AI**" to the students and faculty of the computer science stream.



Focus Areas of the Talk :

The session was designed to demystify the core components of Artificial Intelligence and its rapidly evolving role in the modern industrial landscape. **The key topics covered included:**

Evolution of AI:

A historical overview from simple rule-based systems to modern neural networks.

Generative AI & LLMs:

An exploration of how Large Language Models are transforming content creation and problem-solving.



Academic Engagement

The resource persons utilized interactive demonstrations to illustrate how AI algorithms process information. The session provided students with a clear understanding of the mathematical and logical foundations required to build a career in AI.

Prof. Sudha K. S. and Prof. Karuna Kurbet also highlighted the importance of interdisciplinary skills, encouraging students to integrate AI tools into their academic projects and research.



Expert Lecture on Web Programming: Dynamic Documents using JavaScript

On April 10, 2026, **Prof. S. M. Magi** was invited as a guest resource person to deliver an intensive technical talk focused on the contemporary shifts in web development. The session, titled "**Web Programming: Dynamic Documents using JavaScript,**" provided participants with a deep dive into the logic and execution of interactive web interfaces.



Technical Scope of the Session

The lecture was structured to transition from foundational scripting to advanced Document Object Model (DOM) manipulation. **Prof. S. M. Magi** covered several critical areas of modern web architecture:

DOM Manipulation:

Demonstrating how JavaScript interacts with HTML and CSS to change content, styles, and structures on the fly without requiring a page reload.

Event-Driven Programming:

A detailed look at handling user interactions—such as clicks, mouse movements, and keyboard inputs—to create responsive user experiences.

Practical Insights :

Prof. S. M. Magi emphasized the "**logic-first**" approach, encouraging students to understand the underlying execution flow of scripts rather than just syntax. The session included live coding demonstrations that showcased how a static page is transformed into a functional, dynamic application through efficient script optimization.

Student Interaction :

The talk saw active participation from the attendees, with discussions ranging from the performance impacts of heavy scripting to the role of JavaScript in modern frameworks. **Prof. S. M. Magi** provided career-oriented advice, highlighting the high demand for developers who possess a strong grasp of vanilla JavaScript as a prerequisite for mastering complex libraries.



Resource Person Engagement: Expert Talk on Laravel and Database Integration

On April 10, 2026, **Prof. M. H. Shirur** was invited as a guest resource person to **Basaveshwar Science College, Bagalkote**, to conduct a specialized technical session for final-semester BCA students. **The session was designed to equip graduating students with industry-relevant skills in backend development and modern PHP frameworks.**

Prof. Shirur introduced the students to the Laravel ecosystem, highlighting why it remains the most popular PHP framework in the industry today. The discussion covered:

Key Discussion Pillars

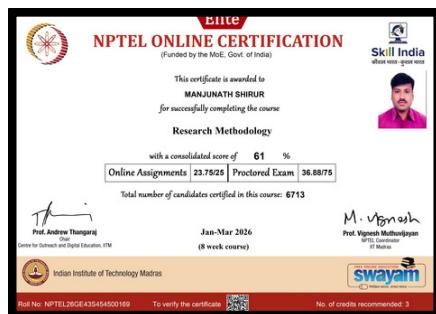
Highlights of the Activities :
