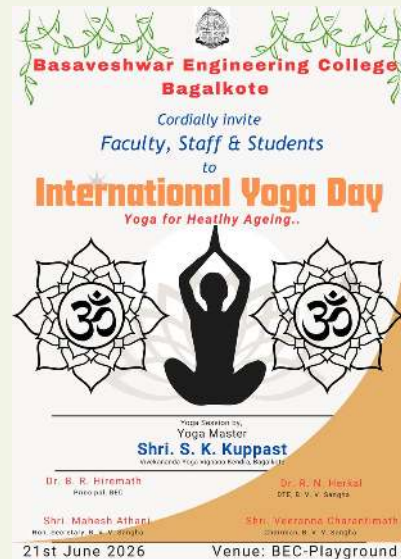
International Yoga Day
